THE ŁÓDŹ OF MANY CULTURES FESTIVAL 2024

The Marek Edelman Dialogue Center has the pleasure to invite participation in the Łódź of Many Cultures Festival, which will be held on 4–13 October 2024. The event marks the most important celebration of urban culture in Łódź. Its 23rd installment will have seen major rebranding, with a new name in place, together with a new format, based on a broad definition of the city's present-day multiculturality.

A new name and programme objectives

The Łódź of Many Cultures Festival, to be held under this name for the first time (it was organized as the Dialogue of Four Cultures Festival from 2002, and has continued as the Łódź of Four Cultures Festival since 2009) boasts an almost quarter-century's worth of tradition, going back to a time when Łódź was recovering from a social and economic crisis caused by a painful period of political transition. Over the years, the festival has transformed into a meeting ground for discussing the pressing issues of modernity. Our understanding of culture has also changed. Culture is expanding, and its scope is not restricted by ethnic or national membership. The Łódź of today is a space where ethnic cultures – Polish, alongside Roma and Ukrainian – coexist, together with feminist culture, queer culture, the culture of the disabled, and the culture of the youth. This observation has served as a departure point for devising a new platform.

Artists from Łódź, from elsewhere in Poland, and from all over Europe have been invited to contribute to this year's installment of the Łódź of Many Cultures Festival. **Premier projects for the festival audience will be prepared by, among others: Daniel Rycharsk**i, one of the most famous artists of the young generation; **Mihaela Drăgan**, a co-founder of the first feminist Roma theater in Romania; **Krzysztof Wodiczko**, a global icon of socially engaged practice; **Victoria Myronyuk**, an Ukrainian experimental movie director; and **Michał Zadara**, a recognized theater artists, who has invited **Andrzej Smolik** to cooperate on the "**400 m**² **nadziei**" [400 square meters of hope] project, which draws upon the activities and writings of Isabella Tree, an author and environmentalist. The festival's stand-out feature will be Poland's first monographic exhibition of works by Ceija Stojka, a late Austrian-born Roma painter and writer.

The Festival will open on 4 October at 20:00 at Klub Wytwórnia (Łąkowa 29) to the tune of a concert under a telling title "**WE**" – **Grzech Piotrowski**, a recognized musician, composer, and producer will reactivate his famous **World Orchestra**, an international musical endeavor which is a medley of world music, symphonic music, jazz, folklore, and film music. The project's ambassador is Urszula Dudziak.

The Festival's program includes events spanning a broad spectrum of creative disciplines, from theater, performance art, motion picture, literature, to music and visual arts, to various forms of artistic activism, as well as the **Łódź of Many Cultures Little Festival**, an initiative based on the idea of fostering rapport between the younger and older generations through art. Once again, the Festival participants will be welcomed by major cultural institutions, local art galleries, and venues not immediately associated with showcasing culture, such as Łódź Fabryczna Train Station.

In addition, between 24 June and 15 September 2024, the organizers are accepting applications for Research-Artistic Residencies 2024/2025 – *The Multiculturality of Łódź: expanding the field*, a new program under the Łódź of Many Cultures Festival. Residency applications are invited from creative individuals who believe that Łódź lends itself to multiculturality-themed narratives expressed through various artistic practices (whose character may be performative, visual, musical, social, literary, or interdisciplinary). The organizers encourage diverse proposals, which may explore selected themes, tropes, and subjects, with the city of Łódź their reference point.
