The list of eligible costs for EPS projects:

- 1. Materials for building prototypes metal, wooden, plastic construction elements, etc.
- 2. Mechanical components, electrical, electronic, elementary modules/subassemblies of various devices/systems, etc.
- 3. "Media", e.g. chemical reagents that will be processed or analysed as part of the project.
- 4. Small laboratory tools and equipment, unavailable in any other manner, and necessary for the implementation of the project.
- 5. The purchase of the software licence needed to implement the solution in the project and not available at TUL.
- 6. The purchase (outsourcing) of the selected services such as PCB design, cutting, milling, etc., the implementation of which requires specialist tools/equipment unavailable at TUL.
- 7. Posters of final presentations, should such a form be required for final presentations (Final Evaluation).

Note!

Obtaining funds depends on the available financial resources in the budget of the International Cooperation Centre. In justified cases, the Director of the ICC may reject requests for funding, despite the fulfilment of relevant conditions by an applicant.
