## BASIC SAFETY RULES IN POLAND

- Cross the road only at the pedestrian crossings and on the green light.
- > Do not drink alcohol in public places.
- > Do not drive vehicles (car, bicycle) under the influence of alcohol (in Poland it is permissible to drive a motor vehicle if the alcohol content in blood is lower than 0.2 per mil).
- > Don't leave your drink in a club or at a party unattended
  - someone could add something to it.
- Do not smoke cigarettes in public places, except in areas designated for this purpose.
- > You will be fined for ticket evasion on public means of transport.
- Avoid walking in dangerous places after dark (parks, dark streets).

- Ride your bike only along bicycle paths, or if there is no path - along the side of the street; get off your bike and walk with it through a pedestrian crossing, unless there is a horizontal sign on the road that allows you to cycle through the road.
- Remember, in Poland there is a ban on the production, sale and consumption of drugs, including marijuana!
- > Use only legal software on your computer.
- > Be careful in crowded places (streets, clubs, concerts), watch your belongings, especially documents and money; when you leave your room in the dormitory, lock it with a key.
- > Have an identity document at all times.
