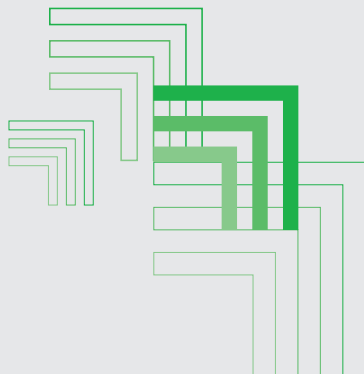

The Library of Lodz University of Technology is the largest technical library in the region, offering access to the most comprehensive collection of documents in the field of engineering sciences. It consists of the Main Library (building B22) and 6 branch libraries. Together with institute libraries they form the TUL library-information system.

TUL Library offers the following services and resources:

- › access to 215 000 electronic books collection (through TUL network and outside of it),
- › access to 19 000 electronic journals collection (through TUL network and outside of it),
- › access to 80 databases – abstract and fulltext (through TUL network and outside of it),
- › space for 670 readers, with areas for individual and group work,
- › 60 computers with free of charge Internet access (with office or dedicated software installed),
- › access to Wi-Fi (based on EDUROAM network),
- › scanners, printers and copy machines,
- › 255 000 book items (print version),
- › 139 000 journals and magazines items (print version), 422 titles of current journals,
- › 245 000 special collection items (standards, PhD theses, patents),
- › access to 12 000 items in CYBRA – Lodz Regional Digital Library,
- › access to CYRENA – Lodz University of Technology Scientific Publications Repository,
- › reserving and ordering loanable books online,
- › ordering book purchases online,
