





Appendix 1 - Financing rules of staff mobility under *The Education Programme*, Component II: *Mobility in Higher Education*

- 1. The following funding rules apply to those carrying out mobility under the agreement EOG/21/K2/W/0005.
- 2. Mobility participants receive a grant to subsidise travel and maintenance costs incurred abroad.
- 3. The grant will be paid in PLN and will be the equivalent of the grant in EUR at the exchange rate of 1 EUR = 4,5565 PLN.
- 4. The amount of individual support for maintenance costs incurred abroad is as follows:

for people going from Poland to the Donor States:

Countries in the programme: Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein	The daily amount of the grant in EURO for mobilities lasting no more than 7 days
1 day	250 €

for people coming to Poland from the Donor States:

Countries in the programme: Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein	The daily amount of the scholarship in EURO for mobilities lasting no more than 7 days
1 day	150 €

- 5. The amount of the travel grant depends on the distance between the place of departure and the destination. For the purpose of calculating the grant, it is assumed that the place of departure, as well as the place of destination in the case of arrivals, is Lodz as the seat of Lodz University of Technology.
- 6. To calculate the distance The Distance Calculator should be used.

Distance	Amount	Allocation principles
from 100 to 499 km	180 €per participant	Distance to be calculated with the calculator.
from 500 to 1999 km	275 €per participant	Distance to be calculated with the calculator.
from 2000 to 2999 km	360 €per participant	Distance to be calculated with the calculator.
from 3000 to 3999 km	530 €per participant	Distance to be calculated with the calculator.
